NOTES

The Kyoto Imperial University Economic Society held its Grand Conference for the Tenth Year of Showa on the 1st and 2nd of June.

On the afternoon of the 1st, a lecture-meeting open to the public was held with the following programme:—

Mr. Akira Mukai, Professor of the Higher Commercial School of Yamaguchi: On the System of Quesnay's *Tableau économique*.

Mr. Shinjiro Asami, Professor of the Higher Commercial School of Hikone: On the Surtaxes of Japan.
