The current number of ZINBUN 47 publishes a series of texts based on the papers presented at the international workshop “‘Power-Knowledge’ or ‘State Apparatus’ ? : Foucault/Althusser after May ’68”, held on March 19, 2016 at the Institute for Research in Humanities of Kyoto University. This event was organized by the research group on “European Contemporary Philosophy and Politics”, active at the aforesaid Institute since April 2011, in order to indicate some new perspectives for further research at the end of a five year-long project.
