This year, Asian and Oceanian Women in Mathematics (AOWM) will be established in Asia and Oceania. In line with this, there is a movement to create a network of female mathematicians in Japan. This conference has selected as a "Promotion of Women's Participation" by the Research Institute of Mathematical Sciences, Kyoto University, and it is planned as a meeting with the aim of creating opportunities for female mathematicians (a minority in the Japanese mathematical society) to gather, start research, and exchange various information.

At this conference, there will be research talks by active female mathematicians all over the world, short talks by young researchers, and discussions the network of female mathematicians overseas. We are also planning a relay talk for all participating female mathematicians.
