### **Overview of Kyoto University**

- A national university founded in 1897
- 8,020 staffs
- 22,600 students (undergraduate & graduate)
- 10 faculties and multiple graduate schools covering a wide range of disciplines
- Renowned for cutting-edge research in science, engineering, humanities, and social sciences



### **Open Science Policies at Kyoto University**

Kyoto University Open Access Policy (2015)

- The first open access policy in Japan
- The policy mandates faculty members to publicize in principle their academic articles on the Internet by depositing them in KURENAI
- Kyoto University Policy on Research Data Management and Sharing (2020)

- The first research data policy in Japan
- "Kyoto University will promote the utilization of research data by sharing it to the greatest possible extent ..."

### Measures for Implementing the Basic Policy

According to "Specific measures to be taken in implementing the basic policy for realizing immediate open access to academic papers and research data" revised 8th October 2024,

Researchers receiving competitive research grants from public funds must publish their peer-reviewed academic papers and evidence data in institutional repositories immediately after journal publication.

#### Target:


- Some competitive research funding, open for applications in 2025
- Peer-reviewed research articles published in electronic journals
- Evidence data required to be published in the publication rules

#### **Overview of KURENAL**

- KURENAI = Kyoto University Research Information Repository
- Launched in 2006
- Purpose: KURENAI electronically collects and permanently stores research and educational achievements generated at Kyoto University, with the objective of assuring their free open access, to further research and public accountability





#### **Departmental Bulletin**

- Departmental Bulletin is a journal issued by a specific department within an organization such as a university
- It serves as a medium for sharing information, research, events, and other relevant content with its stakeholders

It usually does not cost for publishing and reading
 ⇒ Considered as a Diamond Open Access Journal ♥

## How to Collect Research Outputs: KURENAI Deposit System


- A system for faculty members to deposit articles and datasets in KURENAI
- Renewed in February 2025

- Automatically retrieves his/her article metadata from Web of Science and researchmap to facilitate deposits

# How to Collect Research Outputs: KURENAI Deposit System




#### researchmap

- □ A researcher information database in Japan, operated by the Japan Science and Technology Agency (JST)
- ☐ Most researchers have their own profile page, which they manage themselves
- □ Covers a wide range of research activities, including publications, grants, and teaching and outreach experiences
- ☐ Frequently used for **personnel evaluation**, and **grant reviews**
- ☐ Many Current Research Information Systems (CRISs) rely on researchmap
- □ Thus, keeping their profiles accurate and upto-date is essential for visibility and credibility








Connection to external bibliographic databases
