

### 34. The Potentiating Effects of Various Drugs upon the Action of Hypnotics and Analgesics. (III)

In this report the following drugs were used in order to investigate the relationship between the potentiating effects and the anticholineesterase action of these drugs.

Drugs examined: Physostigmine sulfate, Prostigmine methylsulfate, p-Amino benzoylcholine chloride (Me<sub>3</sub>-Procaine), Phenothiazin N, N-ethyl-trimethylammonium chloride (Me<sub>3</sub>-Anergen) and some organic colours (Methylenblue, Methylgreen, Methylviolet etc.)
